## WHY WE RAISE THE RENT


Each year, this community gathers for Raisin' the Rent to raise core operating support for Street Outreach, the Day Shelter and Social Services Center, and Permanent Supportive Housing at St. John Center. While we are gathering virtually this year, your support is more critical than ever and provides a continuum of resources and care for our homeless neighbors.

With the help of Raisin' the Rent, St. John Center is here year after year to help people who need us. Sarah lived outside on and off for 15 years — and in the last two years Trouble has been her constant companion.

Trouble is her dog. Trouble is also a big part of Sarah's support system – and she is his. "People don't understand this," Sarah says, "but I couldn't just leave him to go into a shelter. And I had to wait a long time for housing because he needed to move into housing with me."

On New Years Eve, Sarah and Trouble moved home for good. "I really did spend the first two days in the bath – just enjoying it," she says. "I waited a long time for housing." Her new tattoo bears witness to the values she held throughout her difficult journey. Faith. Hope. And Love.

"I never lost faith, I never lost hope, and the people around me who genuinely loved me never stopped loving me." She credits St. John Center, Free2Hope, Forgotten Louisville and other volunteer outreach efforts with connecting her to the people who would not give up on her. "They were family when I didn't have anyone." "Homelessness is a journey," Sarah says, "but its no kind of life." We Raise the Rent to support Sarah, and so many more, on the journey home. 
Justin and his wife were the first two people we moved into permanent housing in this new year. When I met Justin, he could not say enough about how patient and persistent the staff who helped him were. He talked about the piles of paperwork he could have never done without their steady hands. Excited and relieved he talked about this moment as though he had witnessed a miracle.

When we hand someone a set of keys, the air is light at St. John Center and you can hear circles of cheer throughout the building. Everyone drops what they are doing to make note of the moment, that feeling -- the reminder of why we are all here. Days like these are the reason we Raise the Rent each year, and why we ask you to join us.

Even as we celebrated with Justin, he knew that to stay in housing his family needed ongoing support - support not immediately available with the type of housing voucher that moved him quickly into housing. Without ongoing services, Justin's housing is at risk.

Justin and hundreds of others in our city need housing

combined with wrap around supportive services - like those we offer in our Permanent Supportive Housing program. While our 92 spots in that program are full today, St. John Center is working to expand our support services and access to affordable housing so that more

St. John Center celebrates the remarkable life of our founding Executive Director, Sister Kathleen Sheehan. Sister Kathleen died on January 7th, 2022. In 1986, she responded to the desperate need for day shelter for people experiencing homelessness. She built a team of staff and volunteers who shared her deep commitment to the dignity of every person. She was a fierce and tireless advocate for the poor and disenfranchised, a loving colleague and friend, and a woman who lived her faith fully. Her legacy is present at St. John Center every day.
